

Dear Mr. [REDACTED]:

1. This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of 31 May 2014 regarding any funding or assistance provided for the software entitled Call of Duty 4.
2. Only Marine Light Helicopter Squadron-775 is under the cognizance of the 3d Marine Aircraft Wing. Accordingly, the other commands listed in your request will respond to you in separate correspondences regarding their records.
3. HMLA-775 was decommissioned, and any records for that command were absorbed by Marine Aircraft Group-39 (MAG-39). MAG-39 initiated a search based on the information you provided. Despite this diligent search, MAG-39 was unable to locate documents responsive to your request.
